

## **Underwater Treadmill Policy Form**

Please initial the following policies to indicate you have read and understood the information provided:

PREPARING FOR VISIT:	
	<b>No food for a minimum of 4 hours prior to hydrotherapy.</b> To prevent digestive discomfort, vomiting, bloat, and tank defecation.
	<b>No excess mud/dirt.</b> Please make sure your pet is clean! Be respectful of the pets coming after yours and rinse off your pet prior to their visit if necessary.
	<b>Please notify us immediately</b> if your pet begins suffering from any gastrointestinal upsets prior to appointment, as rescheduling for a later date will be necessary.
UPON ARRIVAL:	
	Please arrive early to allow your pet time to empty their bladder and bowels prior to the session. Please ensure that your pet has every opportunity to relieve themselves after getting out of the car.
	Please leash your pet at all times. For the safety of your pet, please keep them leashed. Many of our canine clients are recovering from a recent injury or surgery so please be mindful of each dog's potentially fragile state.
TANK DEFECATION:	
	<b>Defecation within the underwater treadmill is a serious incident</b> - it can result in business closure for up to 2-3 hours, as draining, sanitizing, refilling, and reheating the tank is necessary.
	For this reason, it is critical that we be made aware of any pet suffering from incontinence or recent digestive upset such as diarrhea.
	If your pet has an accident in the underwater treadmill we will end the session and the <b>owner will be responsible for a</b> cleanup fee of \$100 to offset the cost of business closure & cleaning.
	If your pet defecates <b>three times</b> in the tank we will discontinue underwater treadmill therapy and focus on other therapies.
APPOINTMENT POLICIES:	
	I understand UPRAC has a 24 hour cancellation notice policy. If I am unable to attend my appointment I will notify UPRAC by phone or email 24 hours prior to my appointment time. If I do not attend my scheduled appointment or give proper cancellation notice I will be charged the regular appointment fee. If I am late for an appointment the treatment time for my animal will be shortened to end at the regular time to allow the next scheduled client to begin on time. If I am more than 15 minutes late my appointment may need to be rescheduled and I will be responsible for the appointment fee.
	I understand that UPRAC provides both single-session pricing and package pricing for services, and that package pricing is discounted. Should I purchase such package I understand that the package is non-refundable, except in cases of death.
I certify that I have read and understand this agreement, and that the information above is true and correct. I agree to accept all terms, conditions, and statements of this agreement, and any rules or regulations of Utah Pet Rehab and Acupuncture Center, LLC.
